On April 8, 2019, Mark Reiley, M.D. and David Bonita, M.D. each notified the Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) of SI-BONE, Inc. (the “**Company**”) of their decision to not stand for re-election at the Company’s 2019 annual meeting of stockholders scheduled for June 13, 2019 (the “**Annual Meeting**”). Accordingly, Dr. Reiley and Dr. Bonita will cease to be directors of the Company following the Annual Meeting. Dr. Reiley’s and Dr. Bonita’s decisions to not stand for re-election were not the result of any disagreement with the Company or management.
